Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

First produced in 1954, and widely known as 'Black Label', Wynns Coonawarra Estate Cabernet Sauvignon has established a reputation for displaying excellent varietal and regional characteristics. The wine is produced from only the top 20 - 25% of Cabernet fruit available from Wynns Coonawarra Estate.

A wine of style and stature, and a perennial favourite in auction circles, the 'Black Label' is one of Australia's most collectable wines. It consistently delivers the potential for medium to long-term cellaring. The average vineyard age for Wynns 'Black Label' is 33 years.

2010 is the 55th vintage of this legendary wine.

Matured for 16 months in a mixture of new & older French barriques & hogsheads.

Colour

A deep wine with vibrant purple hues

Nose

Black cherry, blackberry & brambly aromas entwined with dark spices & tobacco.

Palate

Fragrant, bright and pure, with blackcurrant, coffee and violet notes. A core of dark fruit runs through the palate, defining this as a powerful expression of ripe Cabernet Sauvignon. Supple tannins coat the palate & frame all the elements to create a focused, elegant and classic Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon.
