Coonawarra Shiraz 2011

Since 1952 this wine has long upheld Wynns Coonawarra Estate's reputation as a producer of premium Coonawarra Shiraz.

The 2011 Wynns Coonawarra Estate Shiraz is true to the cool climate style of this variety, with a red fruits spectrum (raspberry, rhubarb and fresh early picked cherries) balanced with classical cool climate pepper notes. Seasoned French barrels accentuate the delicate primary fruit aromas, and build the palate structure. The final result is a refreshing, medium bodied wine with great length that can age gracefully but has enough upfront fruit character to be enjoyed from release.

Colour

Bright, vibrant with purple hues.

Nose

The aroma is packed with mulberries, rhubarb and red cherry, with overlying pepper & floral notes. As the aromas open up, a savoury, dark olive flavour carries through to complexing nuances of subtle toast, nutmeg and cinnamon spice.

Palate

A fresh, vibrant and fruitful palate, its structure is supported by delicate oak, providing gentle but well defined tannins. Red fruits mesh with lingering spice notes to create a delicious and balanced drink.
