Wynns Coonawarra Estate Shiraz 2014

Since 1952 this wine has long upheld Wynns Coonawarra Estate's reputation as a producer of premium Coonawarra Shiraz.

Typically the Wynns Coonawarra Estate Shiraz has aromas of ground black pepper, blackberry and distinctive floral notes. Delicate oak is used to match and support the fine palate structure, without dominating its distinctive, cool-climate character. A medium -bodied wine with a lingering finish that will age gracefully in the tradition of the original Wynns Hermitage wine.

Colour

Nose

Classic, cool climate aromas of blackberries and ground black pepper are lifted by musky florals, wet tobacco and sweet spices.

Palate

Rich black and red fruits mesh with forest floor brambles and zesty, cool spice notes. Structured, fine tannin builds the palate to create a fresh and lively wine, with rich yet fine fruit seamlessly moving into toasty notes on the finish. Enjoy on release or cellar for three to five years.
