Sue Hodder, Senior Winemaker

Sue celebrated her 31st vintage with Wynns in 2023. She brings valuable experience from making and marketing wines internationally and has judged extensively in regional, national and international wine shows. Sue has received numerous awards in her career, most recently being named a Fellow of the Australian Society of Viticulture and Oenology (ASVO) in 2021 for her outstanding and meritorious contribution to Australian wine. In 2010 she was awarded Gourmet Traveller WINE's 'Winemaker of the Year' alongside Wynns viticulturist, Allen Jenkins; and in 2016 Sue and Sarah Pidgeon were jointly named 'Winemaker of the Year' at the 2016 ASVO Awards for excellence.

Sarah Pidgeon, Winemaker

Since joining Wynns in 1998, Sarah has cultivated her love of well-cellared, mature wines through her custodianship of the precious Wynns museum wines. A graduate of the prestigious Len Evans Tutorial, Sarah's judging experience spans two decades at both regional and national shows. She has contributed to many pivotal innovations at Wynns, including the development of a rigorous oak selection program, the introduction of world class vision berry sorting, and investigating fermentation nutrition. Sarah was a Gourmet Traveller 'Winemaker of the Year' 2019 finalist; joint winner of the ASVO 'Winemaker of the Year' 2016 with Sue; and finalist of the inaugural Australian Women in Wine Awards 'Winemaker of the Year' in 2015.

Chris Plummer, Winemaker

After a 14 year career in transportation, Chris followed his passion to study wine at the University of Adelaide. There he accumulated many academic awards including the Gramp Hardy Smith Prize, awarded to the graduate with top grades over the course of the Viticulture and Oenology degree (dux). In addition to this, he also won the Kenneth T Hardy Memorial Scholarship in his first year and the Brokenwood Scholarship in his second year. Following vintages in several regions across Australia and the United States, Chris joined the Wynns winemaking team in 2021.

Ben Harris, Viticulturist

Ben joined Wynns in 2010 as a Vineyard Manager and in 2021 stepped into the shoes of industry stalwart Allen Jenkins as the manager of the Viticultural team. In the same year he was also named the ASVO's 'Viticulturist of the Year', which was a career highlight. Ben strives to continue to grow and develop the sustainability practices at Wynns and discover innovative ways to respond to the changing climate within the viticulture industry. A 2022 Len Evans Tutorial graduate, Ben is a board member of Coonawarra Vignerons and sits on the National Biosecurity Committee for Australian Grape & Wine.

The History of Wynns TRUE COONAWARRA HERITAGE

WYNNS HISTORY IS DEEPLY ENTWINED WITH THAT OF THE ICONIC COONAWARRA WINE REGION.



Government surveyor Eugene Bellairs maps the county line later known as V&A Lane, the lane that divides the electorates of Victoria and Albert.

1851

'Billy' Blight builds the gabled wine cellars, completing them in time for the 1897 vintage. Today, the winery remains the centre piece of the Wynns Coonawarra Estate.

1896

David Wynn purchases the winery and vineyards, renaming the property Wynns Coonawarra Estate.

1951

The first Wynns Michael Shiraz, named after David Wynn's young son, is bottled from two exceptional barrels.

1955

1891

Scottish pioneer John Riddoch planted vineyards in 1891 and completed Wynns' famous triple-gabled winery in 1896.

1898 Coonawarra Railway Siding is commissioned.

1954

Winemaker Norm Walker creates the first Wynns Coonawarra Estate Cabernet Sauvignon.

1982

Winemaker John Wade creates the first Wynns John Riddoch Cabernet Sauvignon, which will twice be named Best Red Wine in Australia.



Wynns Michael Shiraz relaunched. It is only made in exceptional years.

1990

Vineyard rejuvenation program under Allen Jenkins, allowing Sue Hodder to craft wines of even greater finesse and elegance.

2001

Sue and Sarah Pidgeon are jointly named the 'Winemaker of the Year' at the 2016 Australian Society of Viticulture and Oenology (ASVO) Awards for Excellence.

2016

John Riddoch Cabernet Sauvignon launched through La Place de Bordeaux and distributed by some of Bordeaux's most influential negociant houses, marking a new chapter for Australian wine in the international market. Andrew Caillard's history of Wynns John Riddoch "Imagining Coonawarra" published.

Coonawarra Terra Rossa WORLD-CLASS TERROIR

Coonawarra's international reputation comes from the regionally specific *terra rossa*. The unique combination of this rich red soil and a cool southerly climate is optimal for growing intensely flavoured grapes. Perched on a low limestone dune around 600,000 years old, Coonawarra's *terra rossa* is a narrow 20-kilometre strip that boasts the most sought after vineyard soil in Australia.

Grapes grown in this cool, exposed environment ripen slowly, developing flavour and intensity, while maintaining balanced acidity. Ongoing productivity of the vines is underpinned by a shallow, unconfined limestone aquifer that provides plentiful water, supplied primarily by local rainfall and supplemented by underground lateral flows from the east. These climatic factors combine with the benefits of the free-draining terra rossa soil to create conditions conducive to producing low yielding, high quality grapes.

The resulting Wynns wines have long been regarded as among Australia's greatest – known for their style and longevity.

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The Wynns Philosophy CRAFTED WITH EXPERIENCE

WHAT IS NOW WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE WAS FOUNDED BY SCOTTISH PIONEER JOHN RIDDOCH. HE PLANTED VINEYARDS IN 1891 AND COMPLETED THE ESTATE'S FAMOUS THREE-GABLED WINERY IN 1896. LATER IN 1951, MELBOURNE WINE MERCHANTS SAMUEL AND DAVID WYNN PURCHASED RIDDOCH'S ORIGINAL VINEYARDS AND WINERY AND RENAMED THE PROPERTY WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE. The Wynn family recognised the intrinsic qualities of Coonawarra wines – their richness and intensity of fruit character – and set out to build an independent identity in the region. They created the famous label that has made the triplegabled winery a recognised symbol of heritage and refinement in Australia, qualities Wynns prides itself on.

With the longest established vineyards in the Coonawarra region ,Wynns is today not only one of the world's finest terroirs, but also presents one of the world's preeminent winemaking and viticultural teams. Together Wynns winemakers Sue Hodder, Sarah Pidgeon and Chris Plummer, alongside viticulturist Ben Harris, patiently develop and culture an annual collection of wines universally acclaimed for their consistent quality and depth of flavour.

2021 VINTAGE CONDITIONS

2022 VINTAGE CONDITIONS

In 2021, the Coonawarra vintage was as close to optimal as we can recall in the last 30 years. The preceding winter and spring were below average in rainfall. A warmer spring led to a great, fast flowering and set. Some "green harvest" was required to achieve balanced yields for quality. There were moderate temperatures throughout the season, with no extreme heat or cold. The 2021 wines have a notable colour iridescence that follows to fruit vibrancy and depth of flavour. In 2022, Coonawarra vintage was a high-quality year without any obvious climate change impacts. After a cold start to the season, budburst occurred in a cool spring. Thankfully, flowering week was ideal – warm temperatures with no wind – resulting in an even berry set. The ideal flowering conditions and above average temperatures led to even red coloring with minimal variability between bunches. Harvest dates ranged from late April into May. This is in line with long term average dates for Wynns Coonawarra Estate. Vintage 2022 exemplifies the Wynns Coonawarra Estate medium bodied age worthy style.



2022 BLACK LABEL CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Wynns Black Label Cabernet is a true icon of Australian wine. First produced in 1954, it has a reputation for ageing gracefully and displaying excellent varietal and regional characteristics. The wine is produced from only the top quality 20 to 25 per cent of Cabernet Sauvignon fruit grown in our terra rossa vineyards. A wine of style and stature - and a perennial favourite in auction circles - 'Black Label' is one of Australia's most collectable wines and Australia's benchmark Cabernet Sauvignon. It consistently delivers potential for medium to long-term cellaring.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

100% Cabernet Sauvignon

WINE ANALYSIS

Alcohol 13.4% pH 3.52 Acidity 6.3gL Resignal sugar 0.5gL

PEAK DRINKING

Enjoy on release, or carefully cellar for up to 10+ years.

MATURATION

Maturated for 14 months in French oak of which 50% were barriques, 44% hogsheads, 6% 3000L oak vats 25% new oak, 17% 1 year old and the balance in two- to six-yearold barrels.

COLOUR

Dark crimson with a magenta hue.

AROMA

Unfolds a wonderfully lifted perfume, as vibrant blackcurrants, tobacco, and cocoa dust lead an aroma underpinned by black plum and fresh raspberry, with a cleanly defined scent of sage adding fragrance.

PALATE

A silken flow of red and black varietal berry fruits burst onto the palate, yet it remains beautifully measured, with its elegant, medium-weighted pulse ably checked by an ultrafine framework of powdery tannin and a refreshing acidity. Its controlled structure, brightness and persistence coalesce harmoniously, reflecting an exceptional Wynns vintage destined to age gracefully, yet still possessive of the youthful balance essential for immediate consumption.

FOOD PAIRING

Miso and ginger poached salmon with soba noodles. The umami qualities of the dish accentuate the subtle savoury complexity of the Cabernet Sauvignon while the salmon's natural oils are kept trim by wine's fine structure.







2022 BLACK LABEL OLD VINES SHIRAZ

SHIRAZ (FORMERLY KNOWN AS "HERMITAGE") IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF COONAWARRA'S HISTORY. THE ACKNOWLEDGED REPUTATION OF COONAWARRA FOR AGE WORTHY WINES HAS LARGELY CENTRED ON CABERNET SAUVIGNON AND CABERNET SHIRAZ BLENDS. HOWEVER, THE VERY EARLY HISTORY (IN THE 1890S) FOCUSED ON OTHER VARIETIES – PARTICULARLY SHIRAZ.

Today Wynns is privileged to grow Shiraz on many prime locations within Coonawarra. These vineyards have stories to tell and a history of quality. We select the Old Vines Shiraz from the oldest of them including the Undoolya vineyard, a rare fragment of the original 1890s fruit colony planting, in between 1894 and 1897. A classic medium-bodied Shiraz palate, fine and silky, Wynns 'Old Vines' Shiraz is a superb example of Coonawarra's cool climate style.

Alcohol 13.1% pH 3.6 Acidity 6.6gL Residual Sugar 0.6gL

PEAK DRINKING

Enjoy on release, or carefully cellar for up to 10+ years.

MATURATION

Matured for 10 months in new and seasoned French oak barrels. 5% new, 38% 1 year old, balance 2–4-year-old.

COLOUR

Deep garnet with a purple hue

AROMA

With wonderful intensity of fruit, its fragrance rises from the glass, revealing a deep swell of darker plum and rhubarb scents with black olive and a subtle floral tone of hyacinth.

PALATE

Classically medium weight, it seamlessly transitions from a layered, silky flow of fresh, darker old vine Shiraz character into a finish of persistent, ultra-fine tannin marked by a plush extension of fruit and a delightful, stony mineral finish. A lightly cured note of pastrami aids the progression, providing a savoury complexity reflective of the fine, mild growing season.

FOOD PAIRING

Duck rillette and dill gherkin with crusty sourdough. The gamey qualities of the duck complement the subtle meaty tones and fresh darker fruits of the Old Vines Shiraz, with the gherkin imparting a refreshing cut which leaves the mouth salivating for more.



New Vintage 2022 V&A LANE SHIRAZ

Amongst the patchwork of Wynns vineyards on the famed terra rossa strip, one special area is V&A Lane. A long, straight road surveyed in 1851 which was the old district boundary between the historical electorates of Victoria and Albert. The mature Shiraz vineyards along V&A Lane ripen early and are among the first picked each season. The resulting wines have a modern appeal being fresh and spicy, yet still maintaining the succulent and silky palate structure of a Shiraz that can proudly take its place on the world stage.

The purpose of V&A Lane Shiraz is to showcase a contrasting wine style from one of our most beloved grape varieties. A purposely early harvest to highlight a fresh red fruit spectrum, naturally lower alcohol, whole bunch inclusion, wild ferments, and the use of larger oak for maturation are just some of the techniques employed to make these beautiful food friendly wines.

TASTING NOTES

VARIETYAL COMPOSITION

100% Coonawarra Shiraz from vineyards on V&A Lane on Coonawarra's Terra Rossa strip. Vine age 50 years.

WINE ANALYSIS

Alcohol 12.4% pH 3.65 Acidity 6.2gL Resignal sugar 0.5gL

PEAK DRINKING

Enjoy on release, or carefully cellar for up to 10 years.

MATURATION

Maturation for 10 months in seasoned French oak 90% puncheons, 10% hogsheads 1 to 8 years old

COLOUR

Bright cherry red

AROMA

Pure fresh first pick Cherries, beautifully fresh and bright. A dusting of cinnamon and half-dried roses. The 30% whole bunch provides background perfume to further elevate the florals.

PALATE

A burst of clear cherry and mulberry fruit, gently supported by soft natural acidity. There is amazing intensity in this lower alcohol, early harvested style. Slow-building powdery coating tannin frames the gorgeous bright fruit and controls the shape with a light rein. Ripe but fresh fruit notes with an enjoyable ease in the palate which gives way to remarkable complexity without challenge. A lingering and lightly mossy, stemmy finish harks back to the whole bunch fermentation. Just delicious.

FOOD PAIRING

Pork and chive dumplings have a touch of sauerkraut in them for a little extra zip, and special chilli dipping sauce. The ease and joy of sharing a plate of fresh dumplings reflects how this gorgeous wine can kick start a wonderful meal with friends.







2022 V&A LANE CABERNET SHIRAZ

The Cabernet vineyards from V&A Lane have long been looked to for their depth and character as important contributors to Wynns top wines. The inspiration for the V&A Lane Cabernet Shiraz comes from the Wynns 'claret story' that goes back to the 1950s, where wines were made to a style rather than being about exact proportions. For this modern version, the grapes are harvested on the same day and then co-fermented.

The purpose of V&A Lane wines is to showcase a contrasting wine style from our two most beloved grape varieties. A purposely early harvest to highlight a fresh red fruit spectrum, naturally lower alcohol, wild ferments, and the use of larger oak for maturation are just some of the techniques employed to make these beautiful food friendly wines.

TASTING NOTES

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

Cabernet Sauvignon 60% Shiraz 40% from vineyards along V&A Lane on Coonawarra's Terra Rossa strip.

WINE ANALYSIS

Alcohol 12.3% pH 3.66 Acidity 6.4gL Resignal sugar 0.3gL

PEAK DRINKING

Enjoy on release, or carefully cellar for up to 15 years.

MATURATION

Maturated for 11 months in new and seasoned French oak barrels 78% puncheons - 22% new, balance 1-3year old, 22% 3year old barriques.

COLOUR

Crimson

AROMA

This wine is bursting with fruit aromas, framed by complexity from slaty and mossy notes. Perfumed notes of crushed orange blossom, pomegranate and a hint of dried orange peel.

PALATE

Co-fermentation of the two varieties creates a layered and harmonious style, with unique tannin structure. This is perfectly controlled fruit, savoury and svelte with effortless flow. Pomegranate and dried orange peel mingle with a lightly herbal hint of tart olive, sour cherry, and fresh almond ginger cake. The wine is beautifully fresh throughout with a pleasant clip of dry tannin giving a nod to the regal claret style.

FOOD PAIRING

Lamb, pomegranate and pistachio pizza with rocket and whipped feta. The complexity of savoury, fruit and tart notes in this dish harks back to the mesh of flavours in this wine.



2021 MESSENGER SINGLE VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Each vintage Wynns select a premium parcel from a single vineyard to bottle separately. In 2021 the Messenger vineyard, in the southern section of the Terra Rossa strip, showed to distinction. The wine is an excellent follow on from the 2005, 2010 and 2015 from this lovely vineyard, which often shows its signature perfume and silkiness to best advantage in a warmer year. Planted in 1975, Messenger Cabernet Sauvignon is a dry grown vineyard on deeper soils.

Alcohol 13.6% pH 3.59 Acidity 6.3gL Residual Sugar 0.5gL

PEAK DRINKING

Enjoy on release or cellar carefully for 10+ years.

MATURATION

Matured for 15 months in new and seasoned French oak hogsheads 16% new, balance 2yo.

COLOUR

Glowing garnet

AROMA

Lovely intensity, with fragrant lavender and sage notes leading into cranberry and red currant, then violets and a hint of soy.

PALATE

Persistent silky tannin frames a generously flavoured wine with crunchy bright fruit. Both red and dark fruits mesh with savoury notes. Cranberry, soy, and lightly smoky tobacco leaf support an elegant, seamless palate which pushes the flavours to a flowing and lingering finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Hand rolled Argentinian paprika beef and green olive empanadas. The lightly spiced meat is freshened by the plush Cabernet fruit and the herbal tones and green olive combine a brisk, persistent aftertaste.







New Vintage 2021 MICHAEL SHIRAZ

MICHAEL SHIRAZ IS WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE'S BEST-OF-VINTAGE SHIRAZ. NAMED AFTER DAVID WYNN'S YOUNG SON, THE FRUIT USED FOR THIS WINE COMES FROM THE BEST VINEYARD SITES IN COONAWARRA AND IS ONLY MADE IN YEARS WHEN THE BEST QUALITY FRUIT IS AVAILABLE. THE WINE IS A LEGEND OF THE AUSTRALIAN WINE STORY WITH GOOD EXAMPLES OF THE 1955 MICHAEL OFFERING AN OUTSTANDING EXPERIENCE.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION 100% Shiraz

WINE ANALYSIS Alcohol 13.5% pH 3.58 Acidity 6.8gL

PEAK DRINKING

Enjoy on release, or carefully cellar for up to 30 years.

MATURATION

Maturated in 23% new oak, 20% 1 year old oak, 19% 2-year-old oak, 38% in 3 year and older oak.

COLOUR

Deep, inky purple hue

AROMA

The aromatic profile is bold and enticing, with an immediate burst of dark fruits. Blackberry and blueberry dominate the forefront, accompanied by subtle hints of ripe plum. A layer of spice such as cinnamon and a touch of clove, add depth to the aromatic complexity. The nose is rounded off with a delicate suggestion of vanilla, a result of careful French oak integration.

PALATE

On the palate, the wine unfolds with richness and intensity. Ripe black fruit flavours take centre stage, with black cherry joining the ensemble. The velvety texture is complemented by well-integrated tannins, providing structure without overwhelming the palate. There is a pleasant interplay between the fruit sweetness and a nuanced peppery note, showcasing the classic Shiraz characteristics. The finish is long and satisfying, echoing the dark fruit notes, and leaving a lingering impression of subtle spices. As the flavours gradually fade, a touch of mocha and a hint of black pepper linger, inviting another sip.

PERFECT PAIRING

Spicy Sausages. Hints of pepper in the wine are a flavour-incommon. A red fruited wine gives freshness to the rich texture of the sausages.
