It consistently delivers potential for medium to long-term cellaring.

Enhanced by soft yet succulent acidity, fine cedary oak, and elegant, pliable tannins, it finishes with a subtle hint of thyme. A beautifully balanced, medium-weight Cabernet, showcasing all the hallmarks of this heritage label.

Perfect Pairing

Tuscan-style baked butter salmon, with fillets nestled in a flavourful creamy sauce infused with garlic and fresh herbs. The sumptuous flavours are beautifully complemented by the fine tannins and gentle acidity of Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon.
