Named after David Wynn's young son, the fruit used for this wine comes from the best vineyard sites in Coonawarra and is only made in years when the best quality fruit is available. The wine is a legend of the Australian wine story with good examples of the 1955 Michael offering an outstanding experience.

Medium-bodied with flavours of blackberry, plum, and dark chocolate. The wine features well-integrated tannins and balanced acidity, delivering a smooth, lingering finish.

Overall: Our Michael Shiraz is renowned for its freshness and silky texture. A standout wine from Coonawarra that reflects the best of each vintage.

Perfect Pairing

Risotto Milanese. The Michael Shiraz's bright acidity perfectly balances the creamy texture of the risotto, while its fine tannins complement the delicate saffron-infused flavours without overpowering them.
