## Black Label The Original Cabernet Sauvignon 2024

Wynns Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon is a true icon of Australian wine. First produced in 1954, it is renowned for graceful ageing and exceptional varietal and regional character.

The wine is crafted from only the top 20-25% of Cabernet Sauvignon fruit grown in our Terra Rossa vineyards. It is a wine of style and stature as well as a perennial favourite in auction circles, Black Label remains one of the country's most collectable wines. Consistently delivering medium to long-term cellaring potential it remains a benchmark for Australian Cabernet Sauvignon.

The 2024 vintage marks the 69th release of this great Coonawarra wine, an outstanding year in which growing conditions were ideally suited to fruit flavour development and our medium-bodied style.

Plush yet fine, with an impressive persistence of flavour, this is a timeless medium-bodied cabernet defined by balance and A finesse.

A core of red fruits and minty freshness is framed by fine tannins and subtle oak. Delicious and true to its origins, this marks the 69<sup>th</sup> vintage of this original Cabernet.

#### Perfect Pairing

Salmon Puttanesca. The vibrant fruit flavours and the fine tannins of the 2024 Black Label complement the richness of whole salmon, while notes of red fruit and minty freshness lift the tomatoes, anchovies and lemon.
